This guide will help you interpret the Assessment Score you received on this International Foundations of Medicine® (IFOM®) Self-Assessment.

International Foundations of Medicine (IFOM) Clinical Science Examination (CSE) scores are scaled to have a mean of 500 and a standard deviation of 100 based on a group of examinees from Europe, the Middle East, North America and South America in the final year of medical school who tested in 2010.

The scores for this self-assessment are scaled to have a mean of 20 and a standard deviation of 5 for the same group. The following information is provided in response to user requests to “translate” this self-assessment score scale to the IFOM CSE score scale. The NBME® does not warrant that any individual performance on the self-assessment will predict performance on the IFOM CSE and cautions users of this self-assessment against making any predictive inferences.

In the following table, locate your IFOM Self-Assessment score and find the approximate corresponding IFOM CSE score in the adjacent column. (For example, if your IFOM Self-Assessment score is 25, it approximates an IFOM CSE score of 590.)
